REPORT OF GOA STATEHOOD DAY- 30.05.2021

Goa Statehood Day was celebrated by SPES's Goa Multi-Faculty College by organising a Webinar highlighting the importance of the day. Webinar was organised by Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of the college on 30.05.2021 from 4.30 to 5.30. Webinar was attended by students of B.B.A., B.C.A. and B.Com. Mr. Ganesh Mishal was the resource person for the same.

Resource Person highlighted how 30th May is the result of the struggle by Goans, for protecting their separate identity as Goans and therefore this day is of historical importance. He added that, In December 1961, Goa was liberated from the colonial rule but major controversy arose as to whether Goa should remain a separate territory or should merge into neighbouring states of Karnataka or Maharashtra. And hence, the opinion poll was held in 1967 - the only referendum in Independent India which decided that Goa, Daman and Diu should remain a separate entity with the status of Union Territory. Thereafter all major political parties sought statehood for Goa.
