






TENDER FOR PROVIDING SECURITY SERVICES (GUARDS) FOR SPES'S, GOA MULTI-FACULTY COLLEGE, DHARBANDORA-GOA CAMPUS AND PREMISES.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

Clause (1) Definitions:

- i. "Acceptance of tender" means memorandum communicating to the Security Agency the acceptance of the tender in the form of work/ service order.
- ii. "The Contract" means the documents forming the tender and acceptance thereof and the formal agreement executed between the SPES'S, Goa Multi-Faculty College, Dharbandora - Goa, and the security Agency, together with the document referred to therein.
- iii. "The Security Agency" means the person/firm/organization with whom the contract is signed to provide personnel for and shall include their heirs, executor, administrator or successors and permitted assignees as the case may be.
- iv. "The Principal" means the Principal of Goa Multi-Faculty College and shall include his successors in office and "the chairman" means the chairman of the managing committee of the society.
- v. "The College" means the Goa Multi-Faculty College, Dharbandora established under of 1984 and "the personnel/other personnel" means persons deployed as security guards, Utility (Gardener) and housekeeping personnel.
- vi. "The Security Committee" means committee constituted by the college to deal with matters pertaining to security at college campus.
- vii. "The terms and expressions not herein defined shall have the same meaning as assigned to them in the contract act 1872 (Central Act 9 of 1972) or General Clauses Act 1897 (Central act 10 of 1897) as the case may be.



Clause (2) For all purpose of the contract the address of the Security Agency mentioned in the tender shall be the address in which all communications addressed to the Security Agency shall be sent unless the Security Agency has notified a change by a separate letter containing no other communications and sent by registered A.D. to the section in charge. The Security Agency shall be solely responsible for the consequences of any omission to notify a change of address in the manner aforesaid.

Clause (3) The Security contract will be valid for a period of nine months (09 months) from the date specified in the work order and may be extended by a period of one year, with the consent of both parties agrees the same terms and conditions as the original contract.

Clause (4) Preference may be given to Security Agencies having registered with the competent authority under the provision of the Goa Private Security Agencies Rules 2008 and having experience in providing security services at industrial/ defence establishments for equal number of security watchman as mentioned in the tender schedule (Documentary evidence may be produced)

Clause (5) The security Agency whose tender is accepted shall deposit with SPES'S, Goa Multi-Faculty College, Dharbandora – Goa, by way performance guarantee, a sum of 1,20,833/- /- **(One Lakh Twenty Thousand Eight Hundred Thirty-Three only)** in the form of demand draft/fixed deposit receipt/bank guarantee issued by a nationalized bank, before the date of commencement of the agreement/service.

The SPES'S, Goa Multi-Faculty College, Dharbandora – Goa, **shall be free to deduct from this performance –guarantee,** all the compensation or other sums of money payable by the Security Agency under the terms of this contract or on any other account whatsoever.

Clause (6) The Security Agency shall be entitled to receive monthly payment upon submission of the bill in duplicate. The rates of services are prescribed on monthly basis and the bill for the previous month shall be submitted in the first week of next month and payment will be made within 15 days of receipt of the bill (of formal agreement is signed). However, all such intermediate payments shall be regarded as payment by way of advance against the final payment to be made after the expiry of the contract period or upon closure of the contract. The bill submitted for payment should be accompanied with certificate to indicate that the Security Agency has complied with all the provisions of the appliance Acts and enactment in force.



Clause (7) (i) The Security Agency shall regularly pay wages to the security guards deployed by it on the College campus as per the minimum rates of wages fixed by the Labour Commissioner, Government of Goa by electronic transfer to their respective bank accounts and shall submit every month, a copy of bank statement indicating such electronic transfer along with the bills while claiming the payment from the college for the next month.

(ii) The SPES'S, Goa Multi-Faculty College, Dharbandora – Goa, shall therefore ensure that the wages of the security guards/ other personnel provided by the agency are revised as per the minimum rates of wages fixed by the Labour Commissioner, Government of Goa as and when necessary. However, such revised wages shall be paid in respect of only those security guards who are actually performing duties on the College campus on the day such revised wages/arrears towards revised wages are admitted by SPES'S, Goa Multi-Faculty College, Dharbandora – Goa.

Clause (8) Payment of wages, contribution to Provident Fund, Employees State Insurance and any other payment due under the labor legislation shall be the sole responsibility of the Security Agency. The Security Agency shall regularly provide the college with a copy of the receipt indicating that contribution towards PF/ESI/other such payments in respect of its security staff posted at the college campus has been deposited. The said receipt shall be accompanied with proper documents indicating the names of security staff posted at the campus for which such payment was made.

Clause (9) Ex-Serviceman shall be preferred as security guard. Security watchman/ Supervisor deployed by the Agency shall conform to the requirements as specified under the Goa private Security Agencies Rules 2008. The Security Watchman shall be more **than 25 years old and preferably below the age of 50 years** and shall bear a good physique and be medically fit to perform the duties of security. The persons employed as watchmen/other personnel should be able to speak in Hindi or any of the local languages in Goa. The person employed as Supervisor should be able to speak both Hindi and English and local languages.

Clause (10) The security agency shall provide the following information to SPES'S, Goa Multi-Faculty College, Dharbandora – Goa, at least a week before signing of the contract with the college.

1. A certificate that each Security watchman/ Supervisor deployed by the Agency conforms to the requirements as specified under the Goa private Security Agencies Rules 2008.
2. List of names/addresses (permanent and present) of the security watchmen/supervisor/other personnel who will be deployed at the college campus.



3. Proof of age of watchmen (**only legally acceptable proofs of birth record**).
4. Details of training imparted to the watchmen/other personnel provided by them.
5. Photocopies of identity cards of all its security Guard/ other Personnel.
6. Health card issued by Directorate of Health Services.
7. Photocopy of Aadhar Card of the security guards/ other personnel provided by them.


The SPES'S, Goa Multi-Faculty College, Dharbandora – Goa reserves the right to terminate the work order if the provisions of this clause are not fulfilled by the Security Agency to whom the tender is being awarded.

Clause (11) The new Security Agency shall introduce all its fully equipped security personnel/other personnel (see **Clause 16** below) **at least 48 hours in advance before accepting** the charge from outgoing Security Agency, if any. All the items issued to each Security watchman shall be personally verified by the designated official of the College. The Security Agency shall deploy only such persons as are approved by the SPES'S, Goa Multi-Faculty College, Dharbandora – Goa.

Clause (12) - (i) Once the list of security guard/other personnel is approved by the College, the Security Agency shall not change the security guard/ other personnel without the consent of the College. Even if the Agency is required to make alternate arrangements in the absence of a regular security guard/other personnel, the College shall be informed about deployment of new personnel.

(ii) Frequent changes in the security guards/other personnel without any instructions from the College to that effect, hamper the performance expected towards maintenance of smooth security arrangements as work indicated above on the College campus. The Security Committee shall review the

deployment of guards/other personnel at the end of every three months for this purpose. In case, the Security Agency is found to change more than 20% of its originally deployed security guards/other personnel over a period of three months, a fine of Rs. 2000/- (Rupees Two Thousand only) shall be levied to the Security Agency and shall be deducted from the performance guarantee.



Clause (13) The Security Agency shall give appropriate training to the security watchmen/other personnel regarding their duties and responsibilities and especially advise them about their behavior with the women employee/ girl students on the campus.

Clause (14) The College reserves the right to ask the Security Agency to replace any security watchman/supervisor/other personnel if it is found that he does/do not perform the assigned duties properly or he is/they are found doing any mischievous activity or found drunk.

Clause (15) All watchmen/supervisor/other personnel appointed by the Agency shall be provided with an Identity Card duly signed by both, the individual staff and the authority from the Security Agency. The Security guard /other Personnel shall conspicuously display the identity card on the uniform.

Clause (16) The security guard/other personnel shall be provided with two sets of uniforms, one set of shoes and shall carry with them a baton along with whistle and a torch in the night (all these to be provided by the Security Agency). The Security agency shall also provide them with raincoats and gumboots during the rainy season. **The Security agency will be charged a penalty of Rs.100/- per security watchman, per instance when a security watchman who is not properly equipped as mentioned above. This amount shall be directly deducted from the monthly, payment of the Security agency.**

Clause (17) The Security Agency shall also provide the following:

The Supervisor shall be provided with the facilities to facilitate supervision on the entire on College Campus. Two bicycles may be provided to the security watchmen, is required.

Dedicated mobile phones shall be provided to the Security guard/other personnel (including the Supervisor) for better coordination.

Under no circumstances, the personal mobiles of the watchman shall be allowed when they are on duty. Every watchman shall be required to deposit his personal mobile with the Supervisor before Proceeding on duty failing which the Security Agency shall be fined suitably per watchman caught using his personal mobile while on duty.




Clause (18) The requirement of Security Guard/other Personnel is as follows:

1. The Security Agency should be able to provide lady security personnel as per the requirement of the College.
2. Security Committee may suggest changes in the timings as required.
3. 1 Security Supervisor to be appointed for inspections of security guards and other personnel and he should be available anytime in case of emergency situations.
4. Security Committee will inform about security concern if any.
5. The Security Agency may assign an overtime duty (at its own cost & decision) for a maximum of four hours to any S/W so that his/her total duty per day does not exceed twelve hours. However, the College shall not pay any extra amount to the Agency for such overtime duties.
6. The Security Agency should deploy adequate number of guards/personnel as per the requirement mentioned above.

Clause (19) The Security Agency shall provide weekly duty chart (Security plan), clearly indicating the positioning of the watchmen to the Security Committee of the College. The beat of the Security watchman at each site will be specified by the Security Committee if necessary. Such plans should be submitted at least a week in advance. Care must be taken by randomly assigning the duties in order to avoid repeated posting of the same person at the same site, as the case may be.



Clause (20) The Security Agency shall not make any alterations in the Security Deployment plan without the consent of the **Principal/Chairman of SPES'S, Goa Multi-Faculty College, Dharbandora – Goa and Security Committee.**

Clause (21) **The Security Agency shall not ask single watchman to work round the clock.** If any watchman is absent, the security Agency shall arrange a suitable replacement under advice of the security committee. The attendance of all the security watchmen/other personnel shall be recorded by SPES'S, Goa Multi-Faculty College, Dharbandora – Goa using suitable arrangement as per the recommendations made by the security committee from time. The security Agency shall provide necessary cooperation for this purpose.

Clause (22) If any security guard/other personnel is found not performing his/her duty as per the security plan, **or is observed to work round the clock (without prior permission of the Principal and Security Committee), an amount equivalent to the wages of one shift per such watchman shall be deducted by the College from the monthly payment payable to the security agency.**

Clause (23) Security guard/other personnel deployed by the agency, at any moment should not entertain their known persons or relatives at college campus without any official reason.

Clause (24) The Security Agency shall at all-time help the College in registering cases with the police in connection with security matters and provide such other assistance and follow up action in the matter.

Clause (25) The Security Agency shall report to the College from time to time any illegal or unauthorized activities carried out in the campus of College. Any encroachments etc., if notice by the security watchman on duty, shall also be reported to the Principal and College Security Committee. The Security Agency shall submit a weekly report regarding encroachment/ dumping on the campus.

Clause (26) The Security Agency shall have to comply with the provision of the contract labour (Regulation and Abolition) Act 1970 and it shall produce a certificate of registration under the said Act. The Security Agency shall also have to comply with the provisions of the private security agency (Regulation) Act 2005.

Clause (27) The Security Agency shall take special precautions to ensure that the vast diversity of flora and fauna at the College campus is guarded with great care. In events of Wild-grass catching the fire, the security Agency shall take appropriate steps to extinguish such fires.



Clause (28) All the Security watchman posted at the college campus shall maintain a register to record the entry of the visitors into the premises during and after the office hours.

Clause (29) The Security Agency shall ensure that all the College office/Faculty buildings/laboratory keys are kept under proper security. A register shall also be maintained by the Agency. The keys may be issued and received by the security guard/other personnel only upon obtaining signatures of the concerned officials of the College in the said register.

Clause (30) It shall be the duty of the Security Agency to ensure that no strangers are allowed to enter the campus of the college campus after the office hours i.e from 5.45 pm to 7.30 am.

Clause (31) The Security Agency shall provide for special surveillance at the College campus especially during vacation and holidays. The security agency shall collect the vacation and holiday scheduled from the College.

Clause (32) The Security Agency shall maintain a register and record the registration number of the vehicles moving inside the campus, around the College campus especially after normal office hours. They shall not allow any vehicles around the campus area any time.

Clause (33) The Security Agency shall keep at convenient places attendance register and will supervise the attendance and mark absence if the watchman of the security agency does not report in time or is found absent. Signature of the Principal or college designated person shall be obtained on the register every day by 10.00 am. During the shift when the Security supervisor is not on duty, one of the security watchman should be assigned the duty of security supervisor. The Security Supervisor or the Security Watchman who is assigned the duty of the security supervisor shall be stationed at the college campus.

Clause (34) The Security Agency shall conduct inspection of entire College campus on daily basis, to check for any encroachment and untoward things/incidences seen on the campus and submit a report regarding such inspection.

Clause (35) The Security Agency shall at all times indemnify the College against all claims which may arise due to negligence of security guard/other personnel engaged to provide the security services. The College shall notify such claims to the security Agency and the Security Agency shall at its own expenses either settle any such claims or conduct any litigation that may arise there from.



Clause (36) Any amount of loss due to theft, damage to the property of the College including equipment, furniture, buildings, fixtures, plants, tress, grass etc. shall be the responsibility of the Security Agency and the cost of such loss or damages as estimated by the officials of the College after reasonable inquiry shall be final and recovered from the Security Agency.

Clause (37) In case there is a theft in College building and if an FIR is filed with the police, an amount of RS.2,500/- (Two Thousand Five Hundred only) per incidental shall be deducted from the monthly bill of the security agency as security towards incidental charges, in addition to the recovery of loss/ damage as contemplated under **Clause (35)**. Further in case any theft occurs in the campus it will be considered as a lapse on the part of the Security Agency which could render the Security Agency liable for the termination of the contract.

Clause (38) If the Security Agency fails to deliver satisfactory services as agreed under this contract, the Principal/Chairman may without prejudice to the right of the College to recover the damage for the breach of contract.

- i. Recovery from the Security Agency as damages, a sum equivalent to double of approved wages of Security Supervisor/Security watchman/Tradesman/ Workers required to be engaged for the services for the period for which service is not provided. The decision of Principal/Chairman shall be final and binding on the Security Agency.
- ii. Engage manpower required for services without notice to the Security Agency on account and risk of the Security Agency without cancelling the contract. The decision of Principal/Chairman shall be final and binding on the Security Agency.
- iii. Cancel the contract of the Security Agency and engage another agency at the risk and cost of the Security Agency. The decision of the Principal shall be final and binding on the Security Agency.
- iv. When action is taken under clause (iii) above, the Security Agency shall be liable to compensate for any loss which the College may sustain on that account. (The Security Agency shall not be entitled to any gain on such action and the manner and method of getting such services shall be at the entire discretion of the College). It shall not be necessary to serve a notice of such action on the Security Agency. The decision of the Principal/Chairman shall be final and binding on the Security Agency.



Clause (39) The College may depute its own Staff for monitoring day to day functioning of the security guard/other personnel deployed by the Security Agency on the University campus. **The Security Agency and its personnel shall follow the instructions of such staff appointed by the College.** Periodical surprise checks may be carried out authorized by the College to monitor the security system and to find out security lapses, if any. *If any lapse in providing security service on the part of security agency/watchman on duty is noticed during such checks, the Security Agency shall pay damages/penalty as decided by the Principal/Chairman.*

Clause (40) The Security Supervisor provided by Agency shall ensure that all watchmen/other personnel take charge of their assigned sites/posts as per the Security Plan or such plans and duty hours as given in Clause 18 above. The security Agency shall carry surprise checks to the security points anytime and shall submit weekly reports. A review meeting may be held with the Security Agency once in three months.

Clause (41) The Principal/Chairman, SPES'S, Goa Multi-Faculty College, Dharbandora – Goa, shall have the powers to deploy additional security guard/other personnel for additional work in exigencies for the smooth functioning of services and the Security Agency shall carry out the additional work in accordance with any instructions which may be given to him in writing by the Principal/Chairman and such alteration shall not invalidate the contract.

Clause (42) If at any time after the commencement of the work/services SPES'S, Goa Multi-Faculty College, shall for any reason whatsoever not require the whole or part of the services as specified in the tender, the Principal/Chairman shall give notice in writing of the fact to the Security Agency who shall have no claim to any payment of compensation whatsoever on account of any profit or advantage which he might have derived for the execution of work/services in full but which he did not derive in consequence of the full amount of the work/services not having been carried out. Provided that, the Security Agency shall be paid charges towards services rendered up to the date of closing the contract.

Clause (43) Notwithstanding anything contained in this contract the Principal/Chairman of SPES'S, Goa Multi-Faculty College, Dharbandora – Goa may issue directives as and when need arises.

Clause (44) Any dispute arising out of this contract shall be referred to the Courts in city of Dharbandora, Goa. The Courts of the place where the acceptance of tender has been issued shall alone have jurisdiction to decide any dispute arising out of this contract.



Clause (45) Ordinarily the Security agency shall instruct their security watchmen to stay near to the College Campus. The Security Agency shall not allow stay of any other persons/Watchmen who are not on duty at the College Campus. No accommodation will be provided by the college.

Clause (46) Except where otherwise provided in the Contract, all questions and disputes relating to services provided under the contract shall be referred to the sole arbitrator appointed by the Principal/Chairman. It is also a term of this Contract that no person other than person appointed by the Principal/Chairman as aforesaid shall act as arbitrator. Subject as aforesaid the provisions of the Arbitration Act 1996 or any statutory modification of enactment thereof and the rules made there under and for the time being in force shall apply to the arbitration proceedings under this clause.

Clause (47) All workers/staff involved at Government site shall compulsorily be covered under PMSBY Insurance Scheme and that every tender shall give a certificate of compliance before awarding the work order.
