Red Ribbon club of SPES's, Goa Multi-Faculty College, Dharbandora-Goa, organised a one hour webinar for the students of B.Com, B.C.A and B.B.A on Saturday, 20th February 2021 from 11.00 a.m. to 12.00 noon on the topic 'AIDS Awareness among Adolescents.' This programme was organised under the guidance of the Principal, Prof. (Dr).Shaikh Mohammad Parvez Al-Usmani.

The aim of this programme was to enhance HIV/AIDS sensitization among students. The program commenced at 11.00 a.m. Assistant Professor Mrs. Kalpita Naik welcomed the gathering, gave a brief introduction of the Resource Person Dr. Priyanka Sahasrabhojane and presented an overview of the topics to be covered in the webinar.



The Resource person for the programme was Dr. Priyanka Sahasrabhojane (M.B.B.S & M.D, Psychiatry) and she enlightened around 91 participants. Dr. Sahasrabhojane commenced the session by highlighting the importance of celebrating 'World AIDS DAY'. She touched upon issues related to global solidarity against transmission, resilient HIV prevention services etc. In the course of the webinar she dealt with the following issues: common modes of transmission, false myths associated with spread of the disease, structure of AIDS, early signs and symptoms of the infection, precautions and safeguards to be followed by the youth, need for early testing and treatment, need for building confidential and safe social systems, early treatment centres etc. She also guided students on how to preserve and

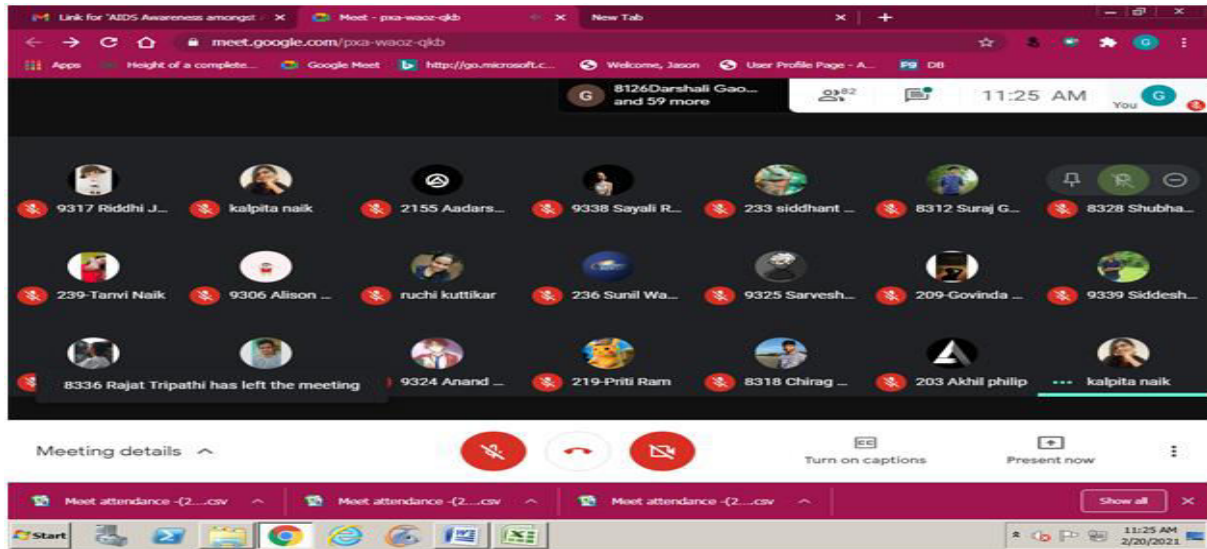


safeguard their own health and wellbeing in modern times

She concluded the session by affirming the belief that programmes like these were important because the youth are the future of this country and therefore they need to be aware of this topic since HIV/AIDS is a real threat that the youth may encounter in daily life.

Assistant Professor Mrs. Kalpita Naik and Asst. Professor Ms. Sandhya Joseph co-ordinated the logistics of organising the webinar. They were assisted by Ms. Ruchi Kuttikar, the College System Administrator.
