

REPORT OF GOA REVOLUTION DAY - 19.06.2021

On 19.06.2021 NSS Unit and Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of the college celebrated Goa Revolution Day. On the occasion, a webinar was organised for all the students of the college from 11.00 am to 12.00 noon. Mr. Vinod Kankonkar, Assistant Professor - History, CES College of Arts and Commerce was the resource person. Recalling the sacrifices of freedom fighters and Martyrs of Goa's Liberation struggle, resource person highlighted contributions of varied freedom fighters from Goa & Maharashtra during times when Portuguese ruled Goa.

He particularly emphasised upon how revolutionaries like Dr. Ram Manohar Lohia lit the torch of freedom and how under his leadership people of Goa stood united against the oppressive system of the colonial rule in Goa to fight for civil liberties. Outlining the significance of Goa Revolution Day he explained how the suppressed patriotic feelings of Goans had manifested into a mass revolution which eventually saw the Liberation of this part of country I.e. Goa on December 19, 1961. Resource Person also urged students to continue to dedicate themselves to handwork, communal harmony and unity to promote prosperity and peace in the state. Session evoked highly positive response from all the participants and Mr. Kankonkar with his gift of gab did succeed in igniting the spark of patriotism in the minds and hearts of the students.
