- ♣ Maximum time to complete the Rangoli is one & half hour.
- ♣ Teams will be responsible for arrangement of the material required to prepare Rangoli.
- **♣** Only Rangoli colors can be used for making Rangoli.
- ♣ The participants will not be allowed to refer to any printed material etc. for preparing Rangoli.
- Any act of indiscipline by participants calls for cancellation of registration.
- ♣ Only one team consisting of two participants from a Higher Secondary School is allowed to participate.
- ♣ Participants are required to carry their ID card.
- ♣ Judges decision will be final and binding.

- Relevance of theme
- Creativity
- Color combination
- Message through Rangoli
- Overall Appearance and appeal
